About Rowallan Camp, Matopos National Park

Rowallan Camp is a picturesque site nestled beneath a massive granite whaleback rock. With quick access from Bulawayo Rowallan is the perfect escape for local and international guests alike – and offers sanctuary in beautiful bush surrounds, just a short way from Bulawayo. The camp is rustic, but comfortable and well equipped to cater to guests looking for adventure and/or relaxation, and families are welcome. The camp is currently comprised of 6 luxury mobile tents, each with en-suite bathroom (hot water bucket showers and flush toilets). The tents offer a refreshing change from a lodge setting for international guests and an exciting option for local and regional guests too. There is no electricity in camp, all lighting is by LED lights, paraffin lamps etc.

Access

Rowallan Camp is situated just 2km inside Matopos National Park with access 34 Kilometres South of Bulawayo along the Matopos Road. 100m beyond the boom gate the road forks left towards World's View. The entrance to Rowallan Camp is sign posted 2km along this road. There is a short dirt road approach to camp.

Activities

In addition to the stunning scenic surrounds, Matopos offers a variety of historical, cultural, sport and leisure activities to entertain guests. For guests on All-Inclusive board basis, activities are included and guests on any other board basis are welcome to pre-arrange these as paid activities. **Until semi-permanent camp open in April 2015 all activities will need to be pre-booked.**

In 2015 we will be introducing additional activities such as mountain bike riding, hiking, as well as climbing the infamous granite whale backs, birding watching and horse riding.

ACTIVITIES FOR GUESTS ON ALL INCLUSIVE BASIS

Unlimited game drives and bush walks included as well as tour of bushman paintings and village visit. Rhodes' Grave incurs additional \$10 fee per person.

OPTIONAL PAID ACTIVITIES FOR GUESTS ON SELF-CATERING, B&B OR FB BASIS

Full day tour of Matopos nett US\$110 per person minimum 4 pax

AM: Bushman painting tour; rock formations, and Rhodes Grave (incurs additional \$10 per person)

PM: Rhino tracking and game drive, and cultural village visits

Half day tour of Matopos nett US\$75 per person minimum 4 pax

Either visit the historical section of the Park including bushman paintings, Rhodes' Grave, villages; or Rhino tracking and game drive

***Guests on self-catering, B&B, D.B&B basis PLEASE NOTE that until the luxury tented camp is built we are using our mobile safari camp where the dining area is in a mess tent and we use a mobile kitchen. There is no restaurant, which means that all meals must be arranged in advance prior to arrival. Please also ensure you bring any drinks you need (outside of what is supplied on your board basis) as there is no shop on site for drinks or ice, so guests will need to bring their own cooler boxes.**
